Saint Paul Hotel's Centennial noted in the Congressional Record

Saint Paul, Minn. (May 2010) —On April 22, 2010, the United States Congress recognized The Saint Paul Hotel as an official part of our nation's heritage. The April 22 edition of the *Congressional Record* (Volume 156, number 58), the official publication of the United States Congress, included a transcript of an announcement by Minnesota Congresswoman Betty McCollum honoring "the staff and owners of the Saint Paul Hotel on the occasion of its Centennial Anniversary," and describing the hotel as "a geographical and cultural landmark for Minnesota's capital city, as well as a gathering place for Saint Paul's many visitors and residents."

The Saint Paul Hotel celebrated its centennial on April 18, 2010, 100 years after its grand opening in 1910.
